### STAR HALF-DAY WORKSHOP

**A good friend is one of the best things you can have

This skill-building workshop is designed to help early elementary aged kids develop the foundations of friendship — including understanding what it means to be a good friend. Through activities, conversations, and crafts in this workshop, we:

- Strengthen their self-awareness of thoughts, feelings, and actions
- Emphasize the importance of kindness, acceptance, and empathy
- Explore problem areas such as teasing, bossiness, and exclusion



**STAR** consists of small group break-out sessions which include **facilitated discussions** on relevant and current experiences, **conversations with peers**, and activities which provide young people with opportunities to learn while having fun. **STAR** is facilitated by trained professionals and includes engaging discussions, games, snacks, stress-relieving exercises, and meaningful takeaways!
